


5 Review the edited movie.

- Choose [Play] to play the edited movie.
- To edit the movie again, repeat step 4.
- To cancel editing, press **MENU** button.



6 Save the edited movie.

- Choose [New file] and then [New file].



- Choose [Save w/o comp.].
- The movie is now saved as a new file.



- To overwrite the original movie with the cut one, choose [Overwrite] in step 6. In this case, the original movie will be erased.
- If the memory card lacks sufficient space, only [Overwrite] will be available.
- Movies may not be saved if the battery pack runs out while saving is in progress.
- When editing movies, you should use a fully charged battery pack.

Extracting Frames of 4K Movies as Stills



- You can save a frame of a movie as a still image by choosing [MENU] the movie control panel in step 3 of "Removing the Beginning/End of Movies" (p.79).

Reducing File Sizes

Movie file sizes can be reduced by compressing movies as follows.



- On the screen in step 4 of "Removing the Beginning/End of Movies" (p.79), choose [MENU] and then choose [New file].
- Choose [Compress & sav.].

- Edited movies cannot be saved in compressed format when you choose [Overwrite].
